The EcoCentre is Florida's first building of its kind — a 33,000 sq. ft., four-story structure incorporating natural "living" systems and "green" technologies designed to save energy, reduce CO2 emissions, conserve water and create an overall healthier working environment. The EcoCentre's integrated rooftop gardens, a valuable amenity, collect rainwater, minimize runoff, mitigate internal microclimate changes and treat graywater. Treated graywater and rainwater are reused in the Living Building to create an appealing indoor Biolarium®, a greenhouse accessible to the public. The project is registered with the Green Building Council and is seeking Gold L.E.E.D. certification.
